



# **An open letter to the President of Ikerlàndia (7th March 2024)**

Dear President Rodríguez

I bring forward an invitation to see changes to the administration of the Keraland Autonomous Region, different to those outlined in the Agreement of Keraland and the Ikerlandian Official law for the transfer of Keraland to the State of Hokoria.

The Royal Office has concerns regarding a lack of participation in Keraland matters from the Ikerlandian government. As a specially administered province of the State of Hokoria, the Royal Government of Hokoria wants nothing but the best for Keraland and is aware of the struggles that the Ikerlandian government is facing to remain involved. We feel that it would be unfair, for Ikerlandia, for the Royal Government of Hokoria to continue administering the province as currently agreed.

I would like to present to you an offer to change how the Keraland Autonomous Region is administered and how the Royal Government of Hokoria will ensure that this province will continue to be a symbol of the strong bonds that the Ikerlandian and Hokorian nations share.



The Royal Government of Hokoria seeks complete control over the administration of the Keraland Autonomous Region, having almost unrestricted authority similar to that of Hokoria's territory bordering the United Kingdom. This control allows for the Royal Government of Hokoria to operate in an effective and efficient manner, eliminating the need for joint-approval of the Monarch of the State of Hokoria and the President of Ikerlândia.

Currently, Ikerlândia and Hokoria both recognise Keraland as a Hokorian province (according to Section 1 of the Agreement of Keraland), meaning that the need for a new agreement would not be necessary. To ensure that Ikerlândia remains to have a part in the Keraland Autonomous Region, in some way, you as President of Ikerlândia will be granted a permanent position within the Council of Representatives in a new Council of Representatives seat for Keraland.

As a Council of Representatives member, you would be able to directly affect Keraland's governance whilst ensuring that operations remain timely and efficient.



One factor that the Royal Government of Hokoria has considered is that Keraland has a unique culture, much different to the State of Hokoria's territories bordering the United Kingdom. The Royal Government of Hokoria will make the commitment to ensure that Keraland services are available in the Catalanian language and that Keraland's culture is valued, celebrated and embraced.
