# TREATY OF MUTUAL RECOGNITION between the

## SECOND COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIS

and the

## **STATE OF HOKORIA**





The two parties to this treaty of mutual recognition, the governments of the **Second Commonwealth of Australis** and the **State of Hokoria**, agree to the terms set below and must strive to obey them at all times.

## **Article I - Mutual Recognition**

The parties to this treaty shall agree to mutually recognise one another as free and independent sovereign nations.

#### **Article II - Borders**

Both parties shall agree to recognise and respect one another's land, maritime and aerial borders, and agree to not claim these areas as their own.

#### **Article III - Representatives**

The Second Commonwealth of Australis will appoint an individual to represent themselves within the State of Hokoria, and in turn the State of Hokoria will appoint an individual to represent themselves within the Second Commonwealth of Australis.

## **Article IV - Dismissal of Representatives**

Should an appointed representative from one party act in a continually unprofessional manner, or should personal relations break down between the two appointed representatives, a party must maintain the right to dismiss the unprofessional representative and request a new representative at the earliest possible convenience.

### **Article V - Micronational War**

Both parties must strive to avoid involvement in any conflict, be it domestic or foreign, in such a manner that damages their professional reputation. Both parties will actively condemn the concept of micronational war.

### **Article VI - Publicity**

Both parties agree to make the signing and ratification of this treaty public at a time of their earliest convenience.

#### **Article VII - Ratification & Annulment**

This treaty shall be considered active upon ratification by both parties through their respective processes of ratification. This treaty is not bound by time, and shall remain in force until one or both parties repeal this treaty, one or both parties cease to be active, or if one or both parties officially dissolve.
