Making Hokoria active in the global micronational community

My department has formed relations with the Second Commonwealth of Australis, the Empire of Levinia, the Communist Republic of Vogelia, the Griftinian Imperial Federation, the Oligarch State of Curnon, the Sprinske Empire and the Federal Republic of Mabruenia. This exceeds our target of 5 nations.

Furthermore, the State of Hokoria became a provisional member state of the Cupertino Alliance as part of our mission towards development. This also opens up opportunities to foreign relations, as has been seen with Australis and Levinia. We're currently the subject of a vote for full membership in the alliance.

We created an Exterior Policy for Micronational Relations which set out government plans, procedure and policy that relates to micronational relations. This suffices our robust foreign policy plans, although admittedly a single policy is the minimum. Our treaties were also updated to create a 'Hokorian standard' of foreign relations through our new Treaties of Mutuality.



Getting citizens involved

Due to the Office of Economics being abandoned partially through the term, we were unable to work on Hokoria's economy. However, we worked with the Department of the Interior to create a system for citizens to get involved in Exterior Affairs.

Increasing transparency

We released a transparency report partially through the term, highlighting what the department had been working on with the Office of the Head of State.

Reinventing the State of Hokoria to our peers

The Department of Exterior Affairs was at the heart of the State of Hokoria's change of national identity, which involved rebranding the Central Government of Hokoria and the State of Hokoria's flag (with the help of Andrew Snye). This sparked discussion with the nations we are allied with.

Overall, I consider the Department of Exterior Affairs' operations over the last few months to be a success. It has been a pleasure serving the people of Hokoria and working alongside the wonderful diplomats and foreign officials that I am grateful for having the opportunity to meet.
